

# BYLAW NO 2018 – 03


## VILLAGE OF CANWOOD


### A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS AND INSECTS WITHIN THE VILLAGE

The Council of the Village of Canwood in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. No person shall keep any cattle, horses, pig or hooved mammal, poultry, chickens, pigeons or fowl, foxes, mink, skunks, or any other animal reared for the bearing of fur or feathers within the boundaries of the Village.
2. No person shall keep any bees or other biting or stinging insects within the boundaries of the Village.
3. This bylaw shall not apply to areas of the Village which are zoned A – Agriculture or UR – Urban Reserve.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw may be subject to the penalties set out in the Village's General Penalty Bylaw.
5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final approval of Council.
6. Bylaw 2016 – 07 is hereby repealed.
