Reminder from RCMP

Due to the increase in thefts within the Village, Shellbrook RCMP would like to remind residents of a few things. Some of the recent incidents of thefts were “crimes of opportunity” and may have been avoided by locking your vehicle, garages and shed doors. The RCMP would also like to encourage residents to call the detachment if they see suspicious activities as soon as possible and not a few hours after or the next day. Try to get as much details as possible and write them down if needed so you can relay the information on to the detachment. NEVER interfere or try and apprehend a suspicious person or persons!

Due to last year's great response, The Village of Canwood will be once again holding a “Clean-Up” day on which we will pick up any items you wish to have hauled to the landfill. Items can be such things as old furniture, metal, wood scraps, old appliances and other items you may have that are not regular household garbage.

Due to its popularity, we will continue with the twist of a “Swap” day, as one person's junk is another person's treasure. Tuesday, May 26, 2015, will be the swap day and anything that is placed on your curb that day is free for anyone else to pick up as their treasure. After lunch on the Wednesday, May 27, 2015, the remaining items will be picked-up and taken to the landfill.

This will be a FREE event for the residents of the Village with the exception of tires (fee based on size) and refrigerators or large appliances (\$25.00 freon disposal fee)

Please place all items for clean-up/swap at your front curb by 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 26. Pick-up of items will begin on Wednesday, May 27 and continue Thursday if needed.
