Leaf & Grass Pick-up

Leaf, grass and garden refuse collection is done bi-weekly on Wednesdays. July and August dates are as follows:

> July 10 & 24 August 7 & 21

We do not mind picking up a few branches but will not be picking up piles of branches. Residents are asked to make their own arrangements for the disposal of large amounts of branches.

August & September Garbage Collection

Please note that Saskatchewan Day is Monday August 5 and Labour Day is Monday, September 2, 2019, resulting in garbage collection to occur on the following Tuesday, August 6 and September 3.

Financial Statements

Please be advised that the 2018 Financial Statements for the Village of Canwood and Auditor's Report are available for viewing. Copies can be obtained in the office during regular business hours.

Overgrown Grass and Weeds

We would like to remind residents, businesses and property owners to ensure that your yard or lot is kept in a tidy manor and that you do not allow grass or weeds to become overgrown.

Animal Control

Council would like to advised residents who are not aware that we have an Animal Control Bylaw. This Bylaw controls various issues relating to animals within the village, such as the number of animals you are allowed to harbor, animals running at large, defecation and creating a disturbance. Another stipulation of this Bylaw requires owners to complete an Application for License and remit an annual license fee. For the year of 2019, the annual fee for licensing your dog or cat is \$15.00 per animal until July 31, and starting August 1, it increases to \$30.00 per animal.

If you have not completed your pets Application for License form please visit our website canwood.ca to locate the application under Administration/Bylaws, Permits, Policy or obtain from the Village office. The fee and application can be mailed or dropped off at the office.

Residential Sewer Line

Please be advised that the Village office is organizing for resident's sewer line inspection, flushing and repairs. On behalf of JS Industries, we are compiling a list of residents that would be interested in this service. JS Industries can repair broken sewer pipe with a fiber glass patch, or can line the entire services from the main to the cleanout with an epoxy. All services are performed from the cleanout in the basement, avoiding costly digs and saving the landscape of your yard. Patching and lining can be done in one day, minimizing disruption to the household. Please also see the insert with this newsletter.
