Water & Sewer Rate Potential Increase

With the excessive amount of water breaks the Village had this past winter/spring, combined with upcoming infrastructure upgrades, we will be looking at a deficit in the Water & Sewer Category this year. In order to alleviate that and allow for future upgrades, we will be applying for a rate increase to come into effect in 2014 of \$10.00 per month per household. The "in effect" date is not known at this time as all water and sewer rates must first be approved by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.

Clean up Day

Due to last year's great response, The Village of Canwood will be once again holding a "Clean Up" day on which we will pick up any items you wish to have hauled to the dump. Items can be such things as old furniture, metal, wood scraps, old appliances and any other items you may have that are not regular household garbage.

To throw a little twist in the event this year (and also due to resident request) a "swap" day will also be added!! As one person's junk is often another person's treasure, the first day will be a swap day – anything that is placed on your curb that day is free for anyone else to pick up as their treasure. Anything that is left on the 2nd day will be hauled away to the dump.

This will be a FREE event for the residents of the Village (A \$25.00 charge will apply to any refrigerators or appliances with Freon, also, there will be a charge for tires beginning at \$7.00 per tire depending on size).

Please place all items for pick-up/swap at your front curb by 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 27. Pick-up will begin on Wednesday, May 28 and continue Thursday as needed.

Items in Sewer

We have noticed an increase of items that must NOT BE FLUSHED in our municipal sewer systems lately. Items such as rags, baby wipes, regular and industrial paper towel cannot be flushed as they can potentially damage the sewer pumps which results in a huge cost to the Village. It could also potentially cause a temporary backup of sewer if the pumps are severely damaged. PLEASE BE AWARE OF WHAT YOU ARE PUTTING INTO THE SEWER SYSTEM.
