BYLAW NO. 2/10

A Bylaw of the Village of Canwood, in the Province of Saskatchewan, to provide for a base tax to be used for hospital fund raising purposes.

PPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPPP

The Council of the Village of Canwood in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Base Tax for Hospital Levy Bylaw".
2. A base tax shall apply to the types and classifications of property included below:
 - a. Residential Land \$150.00
 - b. Residential Improvements \$150.00
3. Where property is classified within more than one property classification by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency, the base tax calculation shall be applied to residential land only.
4. Where two or more parcels of land are owned by the same person, the assessor shall levy the base tax only on those parcels where a dwelling is located.
5. Parcels of residential land which do not have a dwelling located on them shall be exempt from a base tax levy.
