


BYLAW NO. 2022 – 01
VILLAGE OF CANWOOD


A BYLAW TO DISPENSE WITH THE MAILING OF
ASSESSMENT NOTICES

The council of the Village of Canwood, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the “The Assessment Mailing Notice Bylaw”.
2. In this bylaw:
 - a) “Act” shall mean “*The Municipalities Act*”; and
 - a) “Assessor” means a person appointed by Village of Canwood Council as an assessor or, in the absence of an appointment by Council, the administrator.
3. As per Section 214(2) and (3) of the Act, the Assessor of the municipality is hereby authorized to dispense with the mailing of assessment notices where the assessed value with respect to any land or improvement:
 - (a) has not changed from the previous year’s assessed value; or
 - (b) the increase or decrease in assessed value does not exceed the lesser of:
 - (i) \$1,000 from the previous year’s assessed value; and
 - (ii) 1% of the previous year’s assessed value.
4. Bylaw No. 3/99 is hereby repealed.
