

# BYLAW NO 2022 – 06

## VILLAGE OF CANWOOD


### A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS AND INSECTS WITHIN THE VILLAGE

The Council of the Village of Canwood in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the “Keeping of Certain Animals Bylaw”.
2. In this bylaw:
  - a) “Municipality” shall mean the Village of Canwood;
  - b) “Exotic” shall mean an animal not indigenous to Canada and not commonly kept as a domestic animal in Canada;
  - c) “Ungulate” shall mean a hoofed mammal; and
  - d) “Poultry” means domestic fowl such as chickens, turkeys, ducks, and geese.
3. No person shall keep any animals such as cattle, horses or chickens within the boundaries of the municipality.
4. No person shall keep any ungulate animals within the boundaries of the municipality.
5. No person shall keep any bees or other biting or stinging insects within the boundaries of the municipality.
6. No person shall keep foxes, mink, skunks, pigeons (caged or non-caged), peacocks or any other animal reared for the bearing of fur or feathers within the boundaries of the municipality.
7. No person shall keep, fowl or animals used for farm use purposes within the boundaries of the municipality.
8. No person shall be allowed the keeping or breeding of rats, crickets, or any exotic animals within the boundaries of the municipality.
9. Section 3 of this Bylaw shall not apply to areas of the municipality which are zoned FUD – Future Urban Development.
10. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw may be subject to the penalties set out in the municipalities General Penalty Bylaw.
11. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final approval of Council.
12. Bylaw No. 2018 – 03 is hereby repealed.
