## VILLAGE OF CANWOOD **BYLAW NO. 2013-06**

## A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CANWOOD OF CANWOOD, SK TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS SYSTEM AND THE DISCHARGE OF SEWAGE INTO THE **MUNICIPAL SEWER SYSTEM**

COUNCIL of the VILLAGE of CANWOOD, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In all cases, the Village shall invoice the owner of the property to be provided with water and sewer services.
- 2. If a water connection is turned off by the Village at the request of the owner, the following charges will apply:

June 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> November 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup> \$25.00 \$75.00

3. In the case of a seasonal disconnect, the following charges will apply to turn service off and will also be applied to reconnect the service:

June 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> November 1<sup>st</sup> to May 31<sup>st</sup> \$25.00 \$75.00

During the seasonal disconnect monthly fees will not be charged.

- 4. The Village may, by bylaw, ration or limit the amount of water furnished to any and/or all consumers should circumstances deem to warrant such action.
- 5. All rates, costs or charges imposed by this bylaw remaining in arrears (over 60 days) after December 31, may be transferred to the tax roll of the Village and may be levied and collected in like manner as municipal rates and taxes are by law recoverable.
- 6. GST will be added to all fees and charges where applicable.
