

**BYLAW NO. 2019 – 04**  
**VILLAGE OF CANWOOD**

**A Bylaw to allow for the charging of fees for Firefighting & Emergency Response within the Village of Canwood**

The Council of the Village of Canwood, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services provided to the Village of Canwood will be charged directly to the person(s) who received the service as follows:  
  

<u>Fire Truck Response:</u>	
Fire Call Fee	\$300.00
Hourly Rate	\$75.00/hour after the first hour
<u>Firefighter Response:</u>	
Minimum Call Out	\$90.00/Firefighter
After the 3 <sup>rd</sup> hour	\$30.00/hour per Firefighter
2. The Fire Call Fee will not be assessed on reasonably established false alarm fire calls; however, the Firefighter hourly rate will apply.
3. Vehicles/Automobiles- (any vehicle listed in *The Automobile Accident Insurance Act*, *The All-Terrain Vehicles Act*, *The Traffic Safety Act*, *The Snowmobile Act*, and *The Highways and Transportation Act*-) Fire suppression services will be charged to the vehicle/property owner or their insurer(s) and for all vehicle accidents, Jaws of Life services, vehicle fires, and fires caused by a vehicle fire occurring within the boundaries of the Village of Canwood which the Fire Department responds to.
4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final approval of Council.
5. Bylaw No. 2015 – 04 is hereby repealed.
