


SNOW REMOVAL BYLAW

A few important highlights from the Bylaw:

- Residents and business owners will be responsible for clearing the snow, ice and or loose debris from the adjacent sidewalk.
- 2. Residents and business owners will be responsible for clearing snow, ice and or loose debris from adjacent sidewalk within forty eight hours from when the snow, ice or other loose debris was formed or deposited thereon.
- 3. No person shall push, blade, shovel, blow, place or deposit snow that has accumulated on private property onto any sidewalk, street or public place.
- No person shall push, blade, shovel, blow, place or deposit snow that has accumulated on private property other than their own.

Snow Removal Penalties 1st Offence - \$100 2nd Offence - \$200 3rd Offence - \$300
