UPCOMING EVENTS

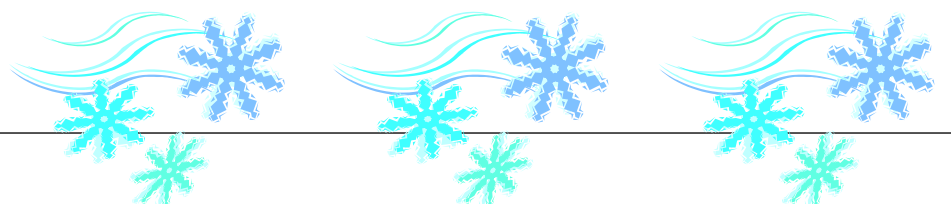
