

<u>Taming The Tiger Is Coming To Canwood!</u> - The goal of this program is to provide children (ages 6-13) and their parents with a safe, supportive environment in which to learn how to deal with anger. Participants will learn the fundamentals of anger, how they react physically and emotionally when angry, and strategies to work through their anger in healthy ways. The parenting

component provides parents with effective techniques to deal with aggressive behavior. The day will most likely run from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. on a Saturday in September or October. Lunch & snacks will be provided. There is no registration fee. This program is funded by Ministry of Justice - Victim Services. Miss Christianson, Canwood's School Social Worker will be organizing this program.
