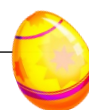
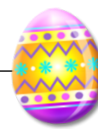
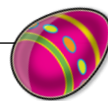
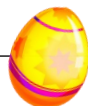
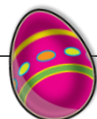
LIBRARY NEWS

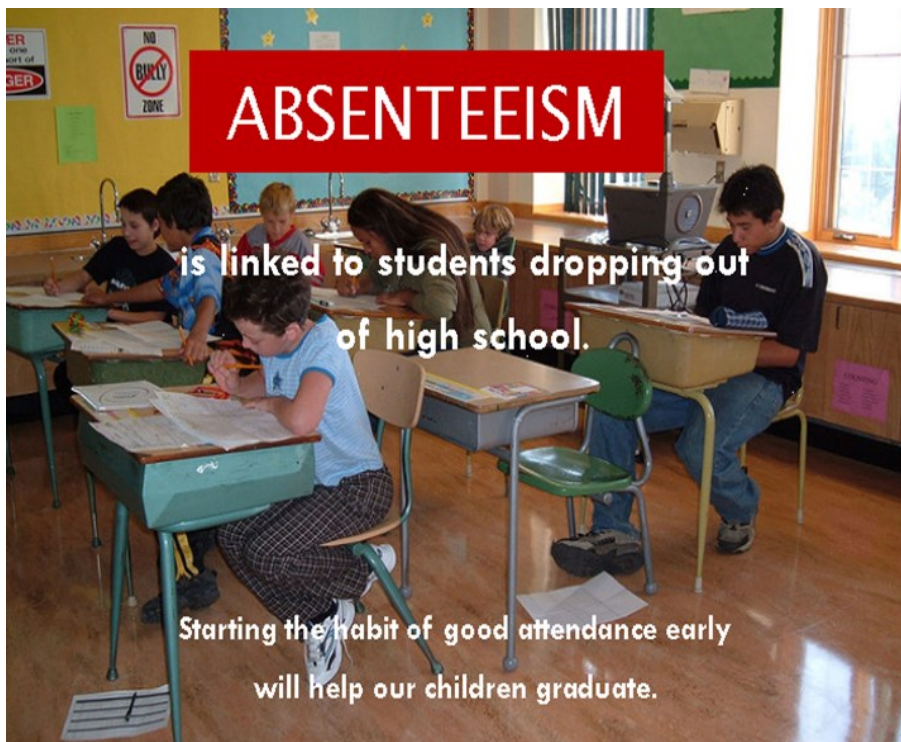
