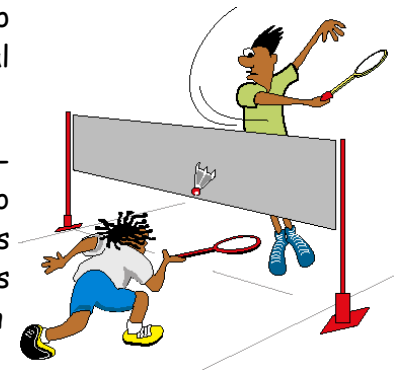

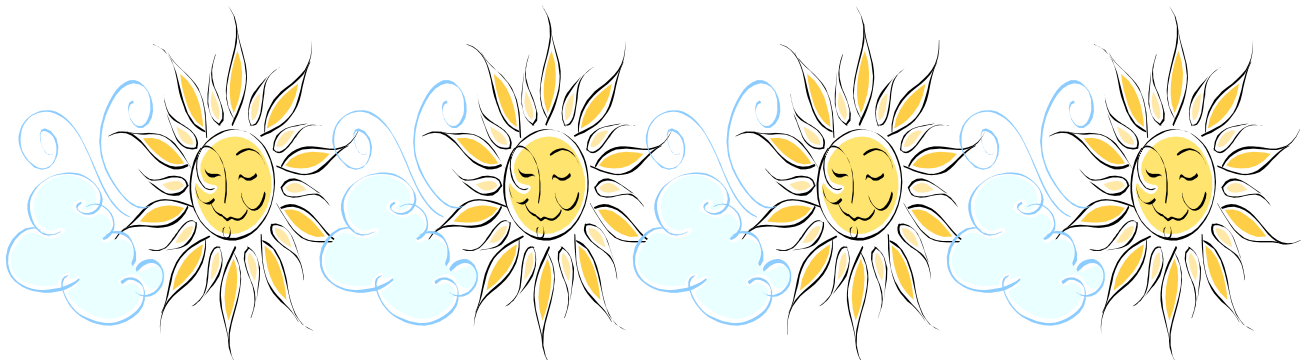



COMMUNITY EVENTS
