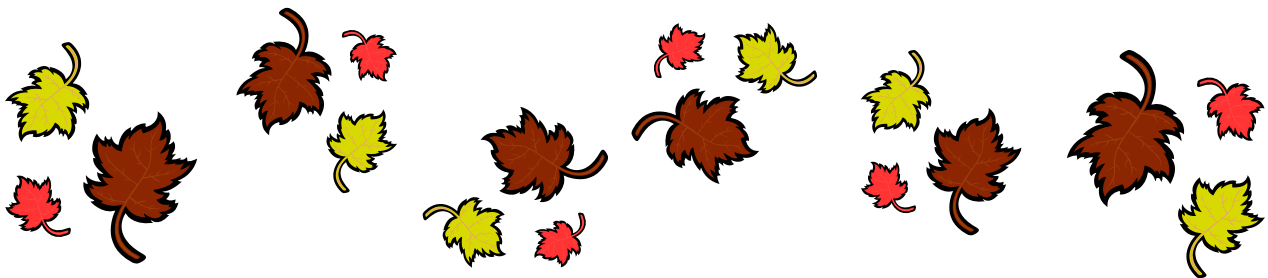
ADMINISTRATOR'S MESSAGE

COMMUNITY EVENTS

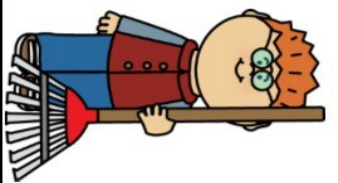



