Pet Owners

We'd like to take this opportunity to remind residents that the Village of Canwood does have an animal control bylaw in place in the Village. This prohibits such things as residents letting their pets run loose in the Village, pets defecating on another person's property and pets creating a nuisance (i.e. barking during the night).

Pets running at large within the Village is a big issue for everyone. Even though you may know your animal is harmless, this does not stop others from being spooked by meeting up with a large animal. Also, even the best behaved animals can get into a situation which causes them to react in different ways than normal, such as showing aggression.

Under the current bylaw, the Village is able to issue fines to anyone contravening the bylaw. You will first be given a warning – either verbal or written – however, any subsequent offences will result in fines being issued.

Please remember to be a responsible pet owner and ensure that you are keeping your pets on your property when they are out and ensure you use a leash when walking your pets.
